Compulsory Attendance Law

The Georgia compulsory school attendance law, O.C.G.A. 20-2-690.1, requires that all children between their sixth and sixteenth birthdays attend school regularly during the entire school year.

McKinney - Vento Act (Homelessness)

The McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act defines "homeless children and youths" as "individuals who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence."
